

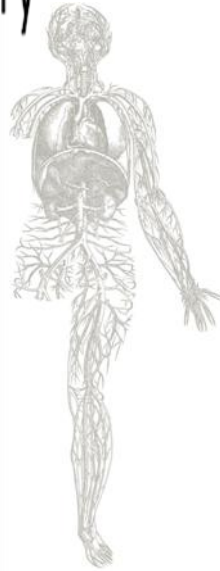

Thomas C. Danisi graduated from St. Louis University in 1973 as an English major. Years later, during a house remodel project in historic Lafayette Square, he discovered new information about Meriwether Lewis. In 2002 he published “The ‘Ague’ Made Him Do It”, documenting that Lewis suffered from incurable malaria. Danisi and John C. Jackson published the first fully documented biography of Meriwether Lewis in 2009. He will present a new perspective on Lewis’ death as published in his recent book, “Uncovering the Truth about Meriwether Lewis.”
